Matthew 7:28-29

28 When Jesus had finished these words, the crowds were **amazed** at His teaching;

29 for He was teaching them as **one having authority**, and not as their scribes.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus teaches:

1. You are not ready to be **doing** the will of God unless you are **being** the disciple of God.
2. You are to live in the world, but not become part of the world system, but you are to rather have a real impact on the world, for eternity.
