DISCIPLESHIP AT CPC: Whole Counsel to the Whole Person

Over the past year, our Adult Discipleship Team has been working through biblical core values for discipleship. One phrase that captures two important core values is the whole counsel to the whole person. Let's briefly unpack this key phrase.

First, we want to emphasize the importance of the whole counsel of God (i.e., the whole Bible). Jesus said that making disciples involves teaching everything that He commanded (Matt 28:20a). If we consider what Jesus taught, it is not merely those things recorded in the Gospels, but also the foundation of those things rooted in the OT (which, in all its parts, spoke about Christ [cf. Lk 24:27,44; Jn 5:39,46]; indeed, even the prophets spoke by the 'Spirit of Christ' [1 Pet 1:10-11]). Hence, obeying Jesus means teaching the whole Bible. Paul, addressing the Ephesians elders, said that he did not shrink back from teaching them the whole counsel of God (Acts 20:27). The context highlights the sense of urgency in this statement. Paul's conviction expressed here was part of his final address to these elders, who he would not see again (v.38), and the sense of urgency is heightened by the very real dangers faced the church would face (e.g., false teachers, their own sin, etc. [v.28-31]). The whole counsel of God is essential in facing these dangers successfully (v.32).

That said, here are just some of the ways in which we are pursuing the whole counsel of God at CPC: our church reading plan through the whole Bible, coordinating what Bible books are being taught each semester so that we are faithfully teaching all parts of Scripture (both OT and NT) and not neglecting any portion (Note: all Scripture is breathed out by

DISCIPLESHIP...

God and useful and practical [2 Tim 3:16-17]), our summer book club selections (focused on the big picture storyline of the Bible), and our officer and teacher training times (equipping our leaders to know and teach the whole counsel).

Second, the very nature of biblical discipleship is wholistic. There is more to it than merely teaching information about the Bible to someone. It also involves following Christ, denying self, taking up your cross, and offering your body as a living sacrifice (cf. Mk 8:34-35; 10:38; Rom 12:1-2). All of these things are wholistic activities, involving how we think, how we fell, and what we do (the whole

personality). This is consistent with Paul's discipleship goal expressed to the Colossians: to present everyone mature in Christ (Col 1:28b). Maturity involves the whole person.

Here are just some of the ways in which we are pursuing the whole person: men's and women's small group studies, community groups, Informal one-on-one discipleship, and our officer and teacher training (equipping our leaders to effectively minister and apply the whole counsel to the whole person).

In all of this, we are wholly dependent upon God to work through our efforts to produce fruit that will last for all eternity. Join with me in praying for just that at CPC!
